Day 1, 15 Sep
Depart Adelaide

Begin your journey to Toronto via Hong Kong.
Stay: Regal Airport Hotel

Day 2, 16 Sep
Hong Kong to Toronto

Arrive in Toronto. Enjoy a welcome dinner with fellow group passengers.
Stay: The Sutton Place Hotel (B,D)

Day 3, 17 Sep
Toronto, Canada

Day tour to Niagara Falls for a full day of sightseeing. Highlights include the '*Maid of the Mist*' cruise and a trip along the beautiful Niagara Parkway, which winds its way along the Niagara Gorge passing through the historic community of Niagara-on-the-Lake.

Day 4, 18 Sep
Toronto to Montreal

Transfer to Montreal to see the highlights including Notre Dame Basilica, residential and financial districts.

Day 5, 19 Sep
Montreal, Canada

Day at leisure. The Old Port is a hub of entertainment, while the Museum of Fine Arts is revered for its collection of more than 30,000 objects. For a respite from the vibrant city, stroll the Montreal Botanical Garden.

Day 6, 20 Sep
Montreal to Quebec

Transfer to Quebec port and board the *ms 'Eurodam'* and begin your cruise of Eastern Canada and New England.

Day 7, 21 Sep
Quebec, Canada

Day at leisure. Visit Quebec's fabulous Old Town which exudes European character and is highlighted by the iconic Château Frontenac. Another architectural gem to see is the enlightening Musée de la Civilisation.

Day 8, 22 Sep
Saguenay, Canada

Day at leisure. Saguenay attractions are the huge Lake Saint-Jean, circled by the popular Blueberry Cycling Route, and the

Valin Mountains, a popular spot for a variety of outdoor activities.

Day at sea

Day 10, 24 Sep
Charlottetown, Canada

Day at leisure. Trace the birth of Canada in 1864, in what is now Founder's Hall near the waterfront. The past also comes alive along Historic Great George Street. Don't miss the Neo-Gothic St. Dunstan's Cathedral or the Confederation Centre of the Arts, to see the original manuscript of the beloved *Anne of the Green Gables*, which was set on Prince Edward Island.

Day 11, 25 Sep
Sydney, Canada

Day at leisure. Historic Sydney boasts several landmarks from the late 1700s, why not visit the colonial Cossit House or the Jost House, which features an unusual beehive bake oven. St. Patrick's, the city's oldest Catholic Church, doubles as a fascinating museum.

Day 12, 26 Sep
Halifax, Canada

Day at leisure. Founded by the British, Halifax still has a British military air about it. See the ceremonial gun fired at the Halifax Citadel every day at noon.

Day 13, 27 Sep
Bar Harbor, Canada

Day at leisure. Established in the 19th century as New England's premier summer resort city. Hike Acadia National Park, behold the sweeping vistas from Cadillac Mountain and watch for migrating humpback whales..

Day 14, 28 Sep
Gloucester, USA

Day at leisure. Since 1623, the town's rugged coastline and sandy coves have enticed visitors to its shores, and with Boston only 30 miles away, if the nearby whale watching and nature trails don't summon you, 400 years of American history will.
Stay: **'ms' Eurodam (B,L,D)**

Day 15, 29 Sep
Newport, USA

Day at leisure. Famous for its Gilded Age mansions, many of which are open for tours, such as the Vanderbilt's opulent Marble House. For a different view of the mansions, take the scenic Cliff Walk. The rocky shoreline is also dotted with lighthouses, including the granite Castle Hill.

Disembark New York, USA

Cruise comes to an end in New York. Transfer to hotel, afternoon at leisure.

Group tour booking conditions

Not Included on tour: Travel insurance; gratuities & tips (some gratuities while cruising, drink waiters, tipping whilst ashore, local guides); items of a personal nature eg drinks, laundry, phone calls, meals other than those indicated, additional sightseeing; optional shore excursions; extensions/stopovers/amendments (if applicable); ¹additional flight cost from other cities, if applicable ²arrival & departure transfers when not travelling on group flight package; ³departure transfer outside of Adelaide metropolitan area.

Reservations: A deposit of \$1500 per person is required within 7 days of confirmation of your booking. The balance is due no later than 13 May 2011 if a booking is made after this date, the full tour price is due at the time of confirmation. Prices are subject to change at anytime until full payment has been received and tickets have been issued.

Booking Forms: You are required to complete some forms when booking a group tour which provide essential information we require to process your booking. Your consultant will provide you with all relevant forms. Please ensure you read these booking conditions in conjunction with the Phil Hoffmann Travel 'Schedule of Professionalism' & Holland America Line booking conditions.

Baggage: The free baggage allowance on flights is strictly limited to 20kgs per person for economy passengers and 30kgs per person for business class passengers. Hand luggage is restricted to 1 piece per person weighing less than 7kg, Whilst on tour one main bag and 1 piece of hand luggage per person is allowed. Airlines may charge you for baggage in excess of these allowances, which will be at passenger's expense.

Insurance: Insurance is compulsory for cover against loss of deposit and loss of airfares, personal accident, medical cover etc. If you have an ongoing medical condition you may be required to complete a pre-existing medical form. If you are over 70 years of age, you are required to complete a seniors medical form. Your consultant will provide all details.

Children: participants must be over the age of 15.

Medical Advice: It is wise to seek medical advice before travelling as you may require vaccinations for this tour. We recommend seeking advice from a travel specialist doctor, or from your own GP.

Passport & Visas: It is necessary for all passengers to be in possession of a valid passport which has at least 6 months validity beyond your return into Adelaide. We ask you to provide us with a copy of your passport. If visas are required, application forms will be provided and visas will be obtained by Phil Hoffmann Travel (additional cost).

Price Alterations: Tour prices specified are based on airfares, taxes and land arrangement tariffs applicable at the time of printing, therefore they may be subject to alteration with or without prior notice until final payment date, as per brochure (final payment date (13 May 2011)).

Minimum Numbers: Group fares quoted for this tour are subject to a minimum 15 paying passengers travelling together. Phil Hoffmann Travel reserve the right to increase the tour price or cancel the tour should the numbers travelling not meet the required minimum. Tour escort travels when minimum numbers of 15 passengers are met. If group numbers are not met, the cruise portion will proceed as independent travel arrangements.

Amendments/changes: A fee of \$100, per amendment will be charged for any reservation changes after your booking is confirmed, unless change increases the value of your booking. This fee is in addition to any charges from airlines, land operators or cruise lines. Bookings are non-transferable. An amendment fee of \$100 per person will apply for any changes to group flight arrangements.

Cancellations: Cancellations of firm bookings will be subject to \$1500 per person service fee plus any charges imposed by principals involved in operating the tour. Therefore, the cancellation fee

may be up to the total cost for land and/or airfares. Cancelled bookings are non-transferable.

Refunds/Credits: No refund is available in respect of any sightseeing tours, accommodation, meals or any other services not utilised or required during this tour. No refund is available for cancellations after the tour has commenced. Credit offers cannot be refunded or taken as cash.

Responsibility: Phil Hoffmann Travel reserves the right to alter or omit any part of the itinerary or change of reservation, features and/or means of conveyance without any notice and for any reason whatsoever.
